

Year 3 Spring 2 Term Curriculum Map

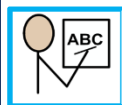

English



We are reading; Fact files, Into the forest and a range of poetry.
We are writing; A fact file about a European country, a fairy tale & Performing poetry.
Grammar; Conjunctions, direct speech, inverted commas, fronted adverbials and possessive apostrophes.
Spelling; Prefixes super & auto, homophones, words with the k sound spelt ch and Y3 statutory spelling words.



Maths

We are following the White Rose Mastery structure. This term we will be exploring maths projects and consolidating taught skills from KS2:

- **Measurement:** Mass & Capacity

Geography
