

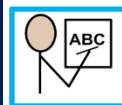
Nest Spring 1 Term Curriculum Map :

Literacy

- Listen to a short story
- Give simple meaning to the marks I make
- Turns pages one at a time and hold the book the correct way up.
- Begin to tune into sounds within the environment



Maths

- Say some number names in sequence.
- Sort objects and explain how.
- Developing spatial awareness.
- Compare amounts
- Combine objects such as stacking blocks.

Physical Development

- To move in response to music
- Climb with increasing confidence
- To drink from a cup without a lid
- Copy lines and circles using gross motor movement.
- To use scissor with a correct grip.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Paint/draw with a purpose in mind
- Understand the use of materials ie glue is for spreading and sticking.
- Explore instruments and the sounds they make.
- Manipulate materials by squeezing, pinching, rolling, squashing.



Understanding the World

- Notice changes in the weather- winter
- Develop an awareness of different celebrations and festivals.
- Continuing to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people.
- Use small world to act out familiar events.



Communication & Language

- Join in with rhymes and familiar stories
- Beginning to link 3 or 4 words together
- Understand a question or instruction with 2 parts eg, get your coat and stand at the door
- Talk in the past tense

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Play alongside others
- Access a range of continuous provision independently for short periods but increasing my concentration.
- Respond to how others are feeling
