

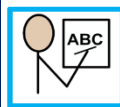
Nest Spring 2 Term Curriculum Map:

Literacy

- Beginning to sing songs and rhymes independently
- I can pay attention and respond to the pictures or the words when its whole class story.
- I can understand and act on longer sentences

- I can add some marks and enjoy drawing freely



Maths

- I know that numbers are in a sequence
