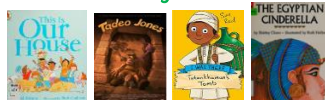


Year 3 Spring 1 Term Curriculum Map

English



We are reading; This is our house, Tadeo Jones, Tutankhamun's tomb and Egyptian Cinderella.

We are writing; A fictional Egyptian story, Newspaper article and a traditional tale.

Grammar; Subordinating conjunctions, direct speech, inverted commas, fronted adverbials, adjectives, adverbs and possessive apostrophes.

Spelling; Suffixes ness/ ful/ less/ ly, Prefixes sub & tele, apostrophes for contraction, words with the s sound spelt ch, s, ss, -ion/-ure sound spelt ss and Y3/4 statutory spelling words.
