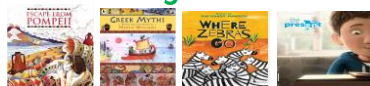


Year 3 Summer 2 Term Curriculum Map

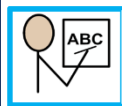
Natural Disasters: Volcanos and earthquakes



English



We are reading; Explanation, myths & Legends, Poetry & descriptive narrative.
We are writing; An explanation, a myth/legend, creating and performing poetry and descriptive writing.
Grammar; Possessive apostrophes, Subordinate clauses, conjunctions, fronted adverbials and speech.
Spelling; ou sound, homophones and Y3 statutory spelling words.



Maths

We are following the White Rose Mastery structure. This term we will be exploring maths projects and consolidating taught skills from KS2:

- **Measurement:** Time
- **Geometry:** Shape
- **Data:** Statistics

Geography
