

## **Uniform and Equipment**

We do not expect NEST and Nursery children to wear the school uniform. Although many parents choose to do this.

Children in Reception to Y6 are expected to wear the school uniform and bring the correct equipment

Please select from:

- Black / grey skirt or shorts
- Black / grey / red gingham dress
- Black / Grey trousers
- Red sweatshirt / cardigan / jumper \*
- Red / White polo shirt or White shirt
- Black / Red tights
- Y6 Red Hooded Jumper (Y6 only) —these should be ordered directly from school.
- Black shoes or black plain trainers
- School Bookbag (Reception—Y2) - This is provided by the school when your child joins. Your child may also choose to bring a rucksack, although we discourage this as space in classrooms is limited.
- Rucksack (Y3—Y6) - child's choice of style, but please limit the size.
- Hair accessories should be minimal and reflect the school colours (red, white, black, grey). Additional accessories such as head boppers, large headbands etc are not permitted.
- Water bottle
- Small plain (gold/silver) stud/s are permitted but must be removed for PE
- Simple analogue or digital watch can be worn. Ones with electronic games / telephone facilities are not permitted.
- Other jewellery i.e. chains, rings etc are not permitted

We have spare uniform in school and encourage parents to use this. Children will be provided with uniform from school if they are not wearing the correct items.

Children should not bring items from home into school, unless requested by the teacher. This includes pencil cases, fidgets, toys etc. Items can go missing and we will not take any responsibility for this.

Clothing does not require the school logo, but items displaying the logo can be purchased from [Myclothing.com](http://Myclothing.com)

**It is essential that all items are labelled with your child's full name.**

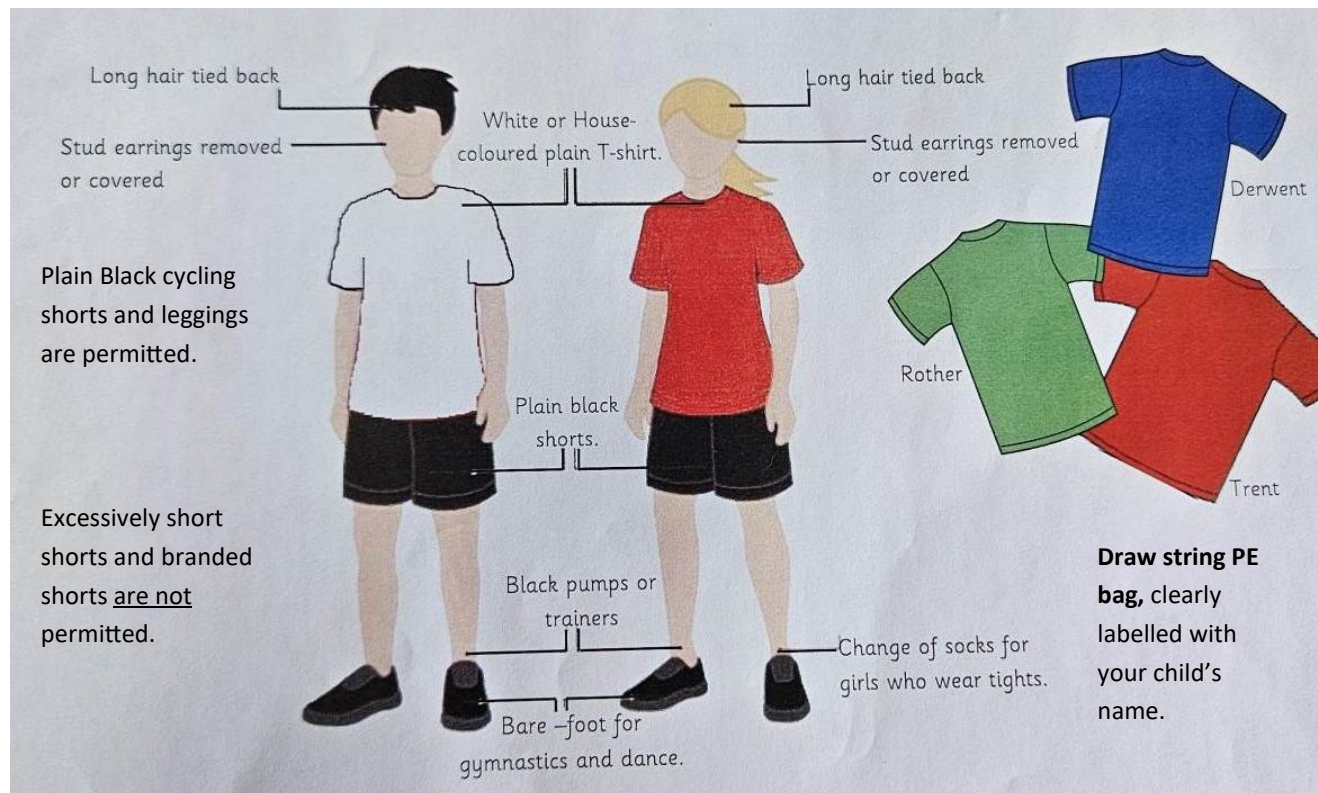
## PE Kit

PE kits apply to children in Reception to Y6.

Reception children **ONLY** should attend school on their PE day, wearing their PE kit. .

For Y1—Y6, PE kit is kept in school, on your child's classroom peg. It is sent home regularly for washing. Please ensure the kit is always in school.

- Black, plain tracksuit OR a School jumpers with plain black jogging bottoms
- Trainers

PE usually only takes place outside in warmer weather. Children may bring these into school on their PE day, just for the lesson.

### Expectations

- All clothing should be clearly labelled with your child's name
- PE kit will be sent home, each term, for washing. Parents should also check sizing at this time, as young children can grow out of clothing very quickly.
- Y1—Y6 children will get changed in school for PE lessons and should not attend school in PE kit (unless requested for special events)
- Children attending after school sports clubs will be changed out of their PE kit before the club finishes, to ensure that the kit remains in school.
- Staff are unable to remove children's earrings for PE lessons and therefore parents should cover them with tape before the start of the school day.
- Children who do not bring the correct kit will be expected to wear a school kit.

We encourage parents to purchase 'unbranded' clothing to ensure that costs are kept to a minimum.
