

Year 3 Autumn2 Term Curriculum Map Finding out about the UK









COT



We are reading; Should zoos exist, Rama & Sita, If I were prime minister, For the birds. **We are writing**; A balanced argument, retell a familiar religious story, persuasive letter and writing an alternative ending.

Grammar; Coordinating conjunctions, direct speech, inverted commas, fronted adverbials, possessive apostrophes, a/an, vowel/consonants, nouns/pronouns & tense.

Spelling; Prefixes mis & re, homophones, words with the i sound spelt y, words ending with the g sound (-gue) and k sound (-que) and Y3/4 statutory spelling words.



Maths

We are following the White Rose Mastery structure. This term we will be end exploring maths projects and consolidating taught skills from KS2:

• Number: Addition & subtraction

Number: Multiplication & division A

RE

What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today?

We will be learning about Christianity, learning where and how Christians show their faith.
